Key tasks

- Ensuring that systems are safe and secure against cybersecurity threats (e.g. securing Linux builds)
- Identifying technical problems and developing software updates and ‘fixes’
- Evangelising about Devops’ ‘The Three Ways’ - helping other parts of the business to optimise processes, get feedback and share the wealth

This role may also involve:

- Working on ways to automate and improve development and release processes
- Working with software developers and software engineers to ensure that development follows established processes and works as intended
- Help with planning out projects and being involved in project management decisions

Candidate Attributes

Essential:

- Track record of working collaboratively
- Prior programming experience – ideally Bash, Python, or Perl, but good programming skills in any language is more important than the syntax of a particular one
- Linux experience (Ubuntu and CentOS)
